- Personally designed and supervised the construction of a two OR surgery center which was a conversion of a vacant A&P grocery store.
- Developed policies and procedures governing all aspects of the operation of the surgery center which opened in 1987.
- Maintained a fulltime surgical schedule at the central Florida location while recruiting and mentoring two full-time ophthalmologists for the Brevard center.
- Sold interest in the center to local ophthalmologists and the AMSURG corp. in 1989.

1988-1993

- Designed and supervised the construction of a 12,000 sq. ft. fully licensed multi-specialty surgery center in central Florida (the first independent, freestanding, ASC in Polk county). This center replaced the office-based facility.

- Recruited a retinal specialist, anterior segment surgeon and optometrists.
- Organized four optical outlets that referred patients to the surgery center.
- Supervised all medical marketing including seminars, radio, newspaper, TV, direct mailing, billboards, testimonials and mobile screening bus.
- Sold interest in the surgery center to local ophthalmologists and Columbia Health Care, Inc.

1993-1998

- Maintained medical and surgical ophthalmology practice in Polk county while building an office in Pasco county.
- Teamed with a local ophthalmologist to maximize utilization of an existing independently owned ASC. The annual surgical volume for this facility approached 3,000 cases which resulted in a sale to VISION 21, Inc.

Refractive Surgery Practice, Orlando, Florida

1999-2007

- Expanded scope of practice to include laser vision correction beginning with PRK and advancing to LASIK.
- Completed construction of one of central Florida's first freestanding LASIK centers in 1999. The laser vision center quickly reached a volume of 200 vision correction procedures per month.
- Mentored several central Florida ophthalmologists through the LASIK certification process.
- Partnered with a local refractive surgeon in 2004.
- Shared refractive caseload afforded time to expand the general ophthalmology patient volume as well as consult in areas of practice management and quality assurance.

The Eye Institute for Medicine and Surgery, Melbourne, Florida 2008-2009

- Returned to Brevard county to work with two surgeons he had recruited and mentored during the early days of his Brevard practice.
- Utilizes the latest technology to evaluate and treat the wide range of ocular pathology common to a busy multi-specialty ophthalmology group. This practice includes an anterior segment surgeon, corneal specialist, two retinal specialists, an oculo-plastics surgeon, two optometrists, two opticians, and an audiologist. The facility includes a laser refractive suite and a two OR surgery suite certified for multi-specialty use as well as a hearing center and an optical lab.
